

Employment rate gives hope to college students

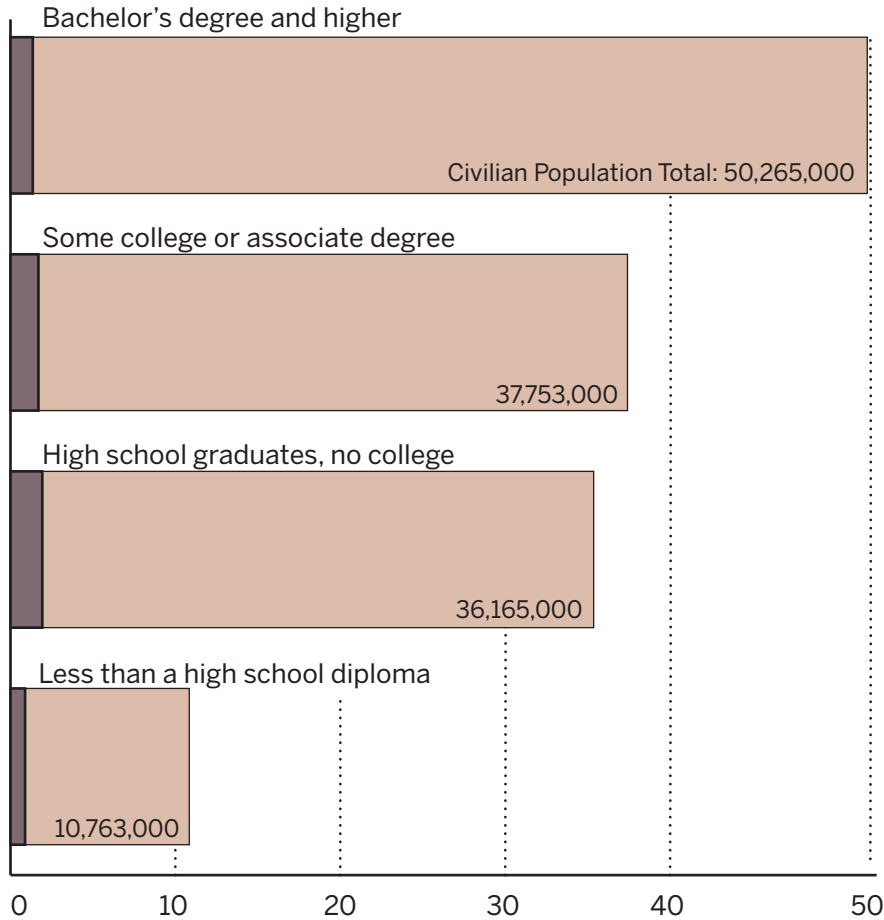

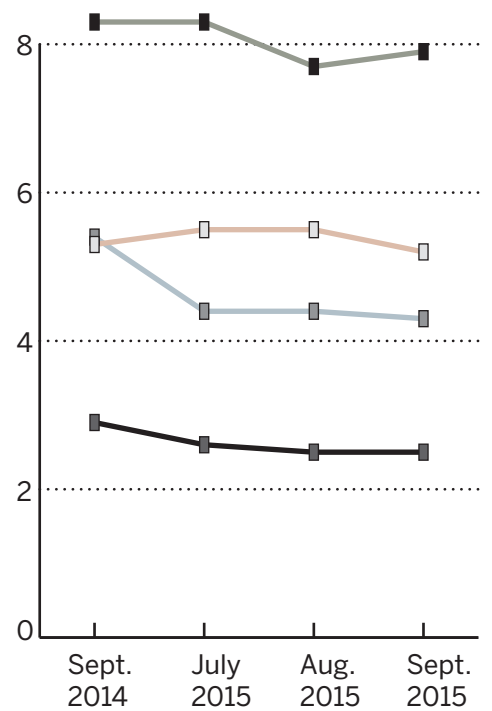
