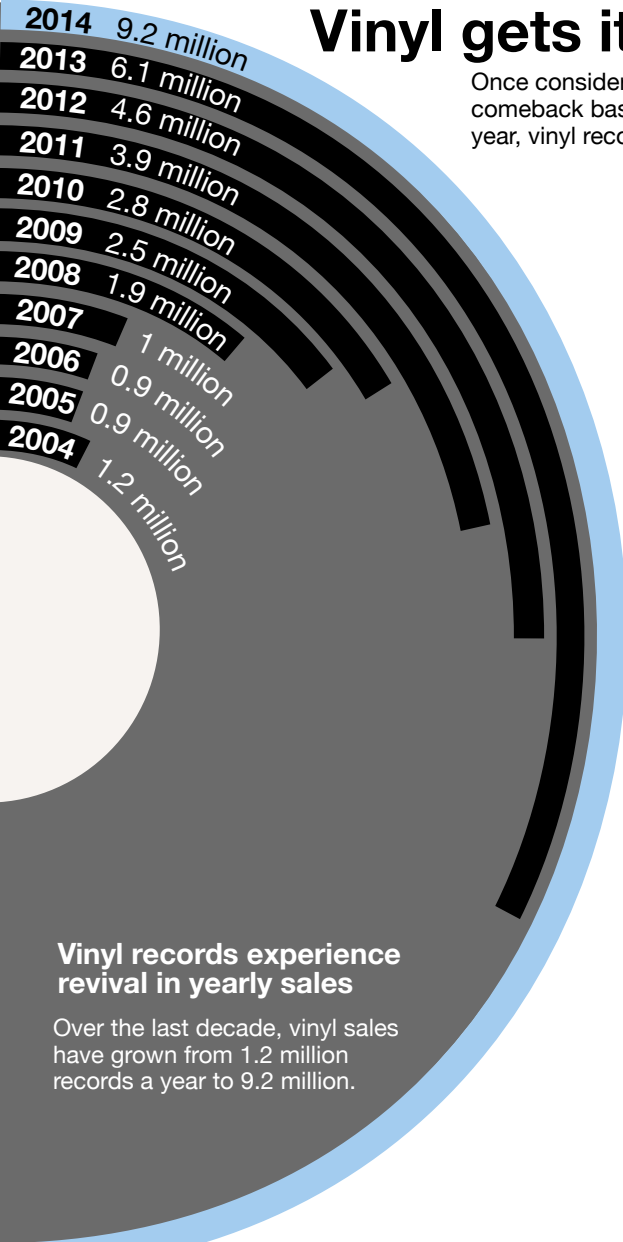


Vinyl gets its groove back

Vinyl records experience revival in yearly sales

Over the last decade, vinyl sales have grown from 1.2 million records a year to 9.2 million.

Vinyl records on the rise

While CD and digital sales declined in 2014, vinyl sales soared, rising nearly 52 percent from 6.1 million in 2013 to 9.2 million.

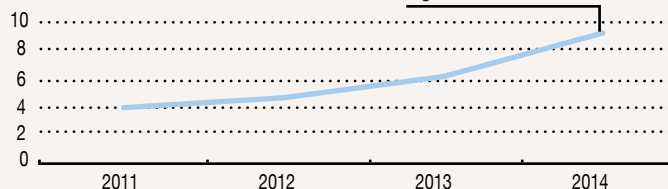


Putting things into perspective
