

## Schwarber strikeout rate less-than-stellar

The Chicago Cubs rookie phenom Kyle Schwarber hit 16 home runs in just 69 regular season games in 2015, on pace for 38 dingers had he played the entire MLB season. But Schwarber also struck out on 28.21 percent of his plate appearances this season, nearly 8 percentage points higher than the league average, 20.39 percent.



## **Tough transition to Majors**

Schwarber's strikeout rate doubled from his days hitting home runs as a catcher for the Indiana Hoosiers in college.



## **Strikeout-prone Cubs**

Schwarber's strikeout rate ranks fourth worst in the Cubs starting lineup in 2015, behind rookie Kris Bryant, Jorge Soler, and Addison Russell.
