

Endangered orangutans found only in Southeast Asia

While the two types of orangutans, Borean and Sumatran, differ in ways such as appearance and behavior, they share the same quality that both types are endangered. The roughly 48,500 orangutans left in the world are only found in the islands of Sumatra and Borneo. The Indonesian islands provide rain forests where the orangutans can make nests in the trees and feast off the wild fruits.
