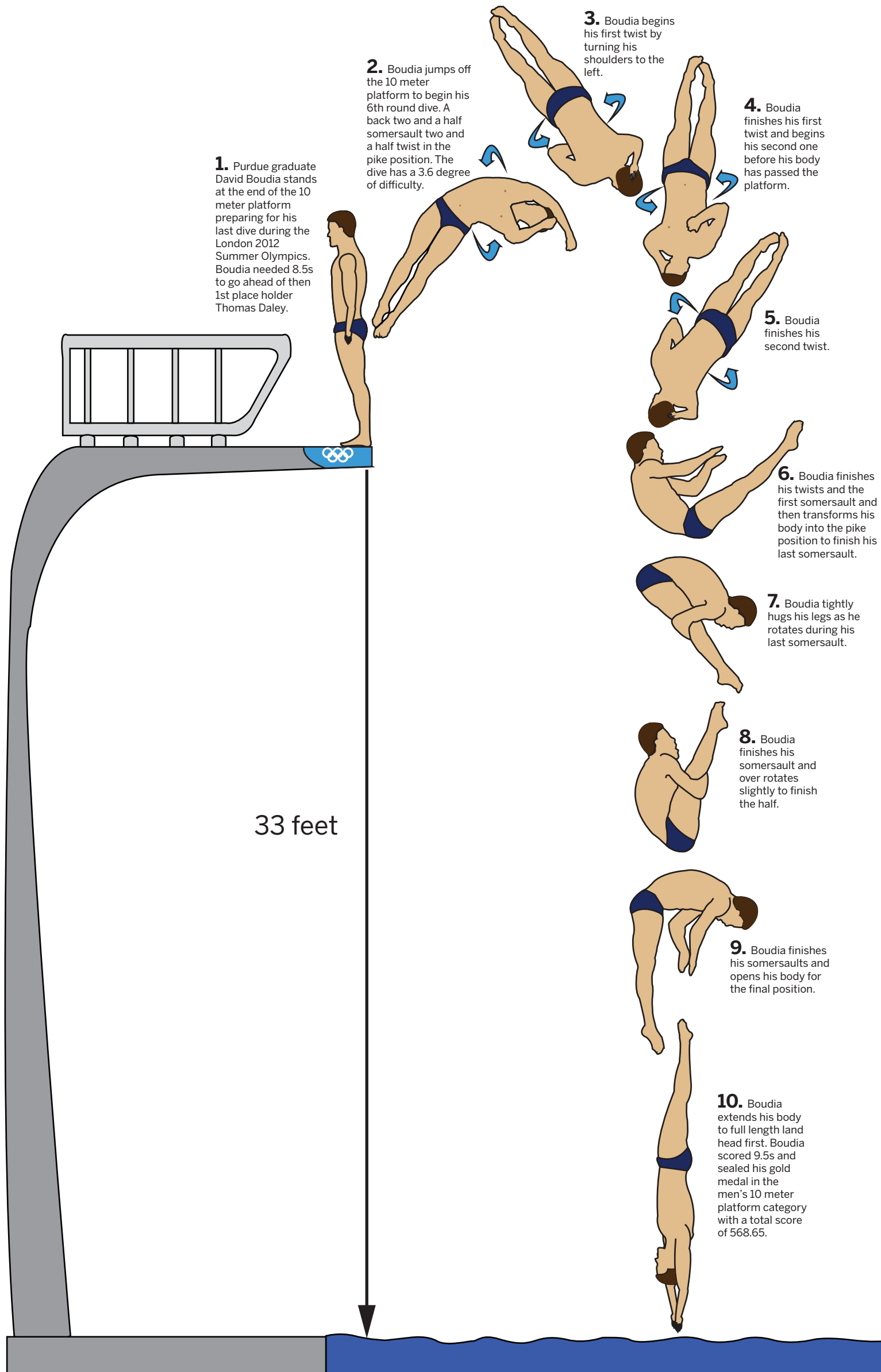


Boudia wins gold in the 10-meter platform

Purdue graduate David Boudia competed in the Men's 10-meter platform during the London 2012 Olympics. After barely advancing from the preliminary round, Boudia dived flawlessly and became the first American male to win gold since Mark Lenzi who competed on the 3-meter springboard during the 1992 Barcelona games.
