

Uganda Change Your preset of HIV

Uganda, a country in East Africa, successfully controls the spread of HIV/AIDS, a major health issue in Uganda from 1980 - 2015. After President Yoweri Museveni promotes "ABC strategy" in 1986, HIV/AIDS infection rates reduce significantly. Back in the 1980s, more than 30% of Uganda population are HIV-positive. Now the adult HIV prevalence is 6.5%. The reduction of multi-sexual partner and the spread of condom usage successfully control HIV newly infection.

In 2015, 57% of the HIV-positive population in Uganda have access to Antiretroviral therapy, a medicine suppressing the HIV virus and stop the progression of AIDS.
