

Utes take their claim on the Holy War

The Holy War, Brigham Young University (BYU) vs. the University of Utah (the U,) has been a time-honored rivalry in Utah since 1922. The two teams have been part of the same conferences up until 2011, when Utah became part of Pac-12, and BYU went independent. Knowing how much the rivalry means to their fans, the two teams have continued to play each other in the off-season, keeping the tradition alive.

HOLY WAR GAME SCORES FROM 1922-2017




NUMBER OF HOLY WAR GAMES WON
